

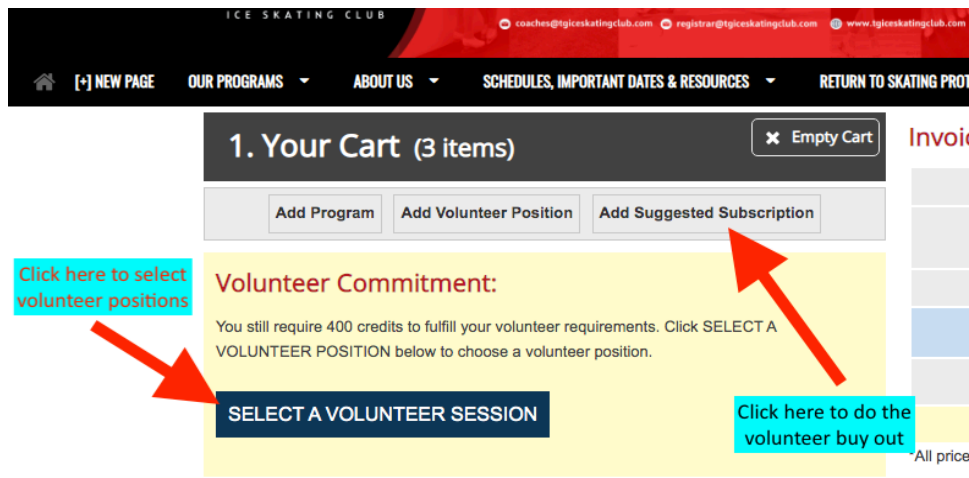

Our Club is growing and in order to meet its many needs, we require many volunteers.*

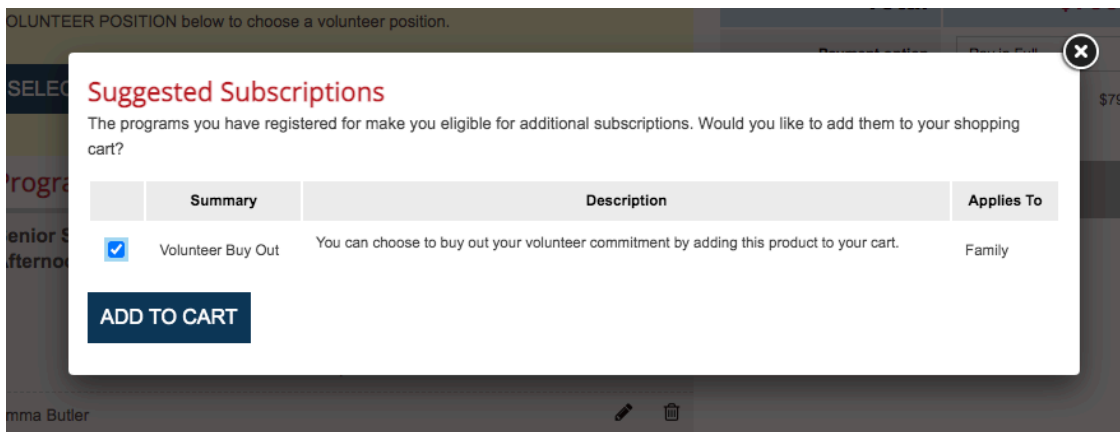
STARSkate families are required to volunteer in some capacity. This year, each family will be responsible for accumulating 400 volunteer credits. We have come up with a list of volunteer roles and responsibilities and have assigned a credit value to each one. During the registration process you will be asked to select enough volunteer roles so that you have 400 credits. **You will not be able to complete your registration unless you have selected 400 volunteer credits.** If you are unable to volunteer this season you may buy out your volunteer commitment for \$400.

On June 1, 2023 we will assess if you have accumulated enough credits in order to meet your volunteer commitment. At that time if your commitment has not been honoured you will be invoiced the \$400 volunteer buy out fee.

The general categories for volunteer positions are: Executive, Organizers and Helpers, Maintenance/Organization, Communication, Welcome Desk, and Miscellaneous.
